Suggestions of proof to submit for Field Crops

Minimum of 20 acres (Permanent Crops Minimum of 10 acres)

- Purchasing or renting machinery/ equipment- rental agreement or sales receipts
- Receipts for fertilizer purchased
- Receipts for seed purchased
- Record of sales for three out of the past five years
- Irrigation records
- You can submit copies of your schedule F forms filed by the farming operation with the IRS for the last three years. (Not required- it's optional)

Suggestions of proof to submit for Production

(Land devoted to high density use for producing commodities such as dairies, feedlots, hydroponic vegetables, wholesale nurseries (retail nurseries are considered commercial), etc.)

- Current profit and loss statement 3 years out of the last 5 years
- Business plan
- Receipts for supplies (such as feed, seeds, casing and etc.)
- Purchasing or renting machinery/ equipment- rental agreement or sales receipts
- You can submit copies of your schedule F forms filed by the ranching operation with the IRS for the last three years. (Not required- it's optional)

Suggestions of proof to submit for Grazing

Use carrying capacity work sheet

- Records for sale and/or purchase of livestock (bill of sale is provided when transferring ownership of the animal)
- Copy of the Arizona Department of Agriculture Brand Certificate (ADA)
- Copy of the government lease or permit for each lease (Bureau of Land Management (BLM), USDA- Forest Service (National Forest Lease) or Arizona State Lease)
- Proof of fencing, livestock water, irrigation ditches and canals
- Records of veterinary and other services provided for the health of the animals.
- You can submit copies of your schedule F forms filed by the ranching operation with the IRS for the last three years. (Not required- it's optional)

Suggestions of proof to submit for Commercial Breeding/ raising, boarding or training; Or rescue facility

Land and improvements devoted to the commercial breeding, raising, boarding or training of equine.

Equine properties are classified as commercial equine.

Equine rescue facilities – Must be registered with the Department of Agriculture pursuant to section 3-1350.

- Income/ expense forms for the last three years
- Records for sale/ breeding of horses for the last three years
- Breeding of registered horse fact sheet
- Copy of boarding/ training contract
- Schedule of horses currently being boarded
- Records of veterinary and other services provided for the health of the animals.
- Equine rescue facilities must be registered per Department of Agriculture pursuant to section 3-1350
- You can submit copies of your schedule F forms filed by the ranching operation with the IRS for the last three years. (Not required- it's optional)
